Bremerton Old Adam Shiraz, Langhorne Creek SA \$80 An excellent example of premium Langhorne Creek shiraz, showing intensity of rich fruit flavours and elegant

Hentley Farm The Beast Shiraz, Barossa Valley SA \$110 The Beast embodies a powerful concentration of flavour and bold richness. Structured with soft grippy tannin and balanced with enticing complexity, a robust wine befitting

Mitolo 'Marsican' Shiraz, McLaren Vale SA \$190

Immediately rich yet elegant bouquet, deep dark plum and baked cherries. Nutmeg, chocolate and coffee hints build with time. Layered and complex, texture beginning silky smooth and highly polished. Tannin intensity climbs to provide assertive and very fine tannins, offering perfect support to carry blackberry, satsuma and dark plum, and rich cherry through the very long palate.



Robert Oatley Limited Release Shiraz, Barossa SA \$85 Full-bodied, richly textured, densely flavoured.



Rymill The Surveyor Cabernet Sauvignon, Coonawarra SA

Rich ripe blackberries, boysenberry, and exotic spice, balanced by smoky, vanilla French oak. Deep, driving black forest fruits and brooding spice. Cased in beautiful oak notes of baking spices, fresh roast coffee and dark chocolate.



Best's Thomson Family Shiraz, Great Western VIC \$200

Very closed to begin, but opens in time to reveal a tapestry of deeply scented aromas including plum skins, exotic spices, concentrated dark fruits, rose petals and grilled nuts. Very rich although only medium bodied. It is broody then expansive, intense but round then focused to a firstclass line and length.
